Home learning tasks will be set each Friday. Helpful information to support you with tasks and website links will be on Google Classroom.

Reception		
Reading	10 minutes daily	Please record reading that has taken place in reading records, this may be a phonics book or a book for pleasure. This could also include when you read to your child.
Maths	Every other week	Number tasks will be sent home every other week to support practical Maths at home.
Phonics	Every other week	Tasks will be sent home every other week to support phonics at home. These can either be completed on the sheets given and handed in or you can upload a picture of the completed task to Google Classroom.

Year 1		
Reading	10 mins daily	Please record reading that has taken place in reading records, this may be a phonics book or a book for pleasure. This could also include when you read to your child.
Phonics	Weekly	Online – Teach your monster to read. Children will have a login and will need to use their phonics skills to progress through the planets and levels.
Maths	1x weekly	Maths tasks will focus on place value and arithmetic skills, using suggested websites.
Spelling – 4 key spellings	2x weekly	These will be stuck into your child's reading record and available on Google Classroom. Please support them to practise their spellings.

Year 2		
Reading	15 mins daily	Please record reading that has taken place in reading records, this may be a phonics book, an Accelerated reader book or a book for pleasure. This could also include when you read to your child.
Maths	2 x weekly	Maths tasks will focus on times tables and arithmetic skills, using suggested websites.
Spelling – 4 key spellings	3x weekly	These will be stuck into your child's reading record and available on Google Classroom. Please support them to practise their spellings.

Years 3 and 4		
Reading	20 mins daily	Please record reading that has taken place in reading records, this may be a phonics book, an Accelerated reader book or a book for pleasure. This could also include when you read to your child.
Maths	3 x weekly	Arithmetic or times tables tasks to be completed 3 x over the week, using the suggest websites.
Spelling - 5 key spellings	3x weekly	These will be stuck into your child's reading record. Please support them to practise their spellings.

Years 5 and 6		
Reading	25 - 30 mins daily	Please record reading in reading records, this may be an Accelerated reader book or a book for pleasure. This could also include when you read to your child.
Maths	3 x weekly	Arithmetic or times tables tasks to be completed 3 x over the week, using the suggest websites.
Spelling – 5 key spellings	3x weekly	These will be stuck into your child's reading record. Please support them to practise their spellings.
Please notes, Year 6 may receive some additional homework prior to SATs to enable them to practise the style of questions they will encounter in the tests.		



When will my child bring home reading books?

EYFS and Key Stage 1

Phonics books will be issued and changed once a week, this is so that the book you are issued can be shared more than once so that your child can practise their reading with words they are becoming more familiar with. This will help them become more fluent readers. Your child will also have the opportunity to select a book of their choice to read for pleasure. This could be a book that an adult needs to read to them. When they are ready, children in Year 2 will be encouraged to become more independent when selecting their books to read.

Key Stage 2

The children will be responsible for changing their own reading books in line with Accelerated Reader and their ZPD, children will be supported with this when needed. The children will also get the opportunity to select a book for pleasure.

How will I know when my child has been read with?

It is our expectation that children read to an adult at school on a weekly basis. This will be recorded in the reading records through use of a stamp.

How will I know that you have checked my child's reading and homework?

Each class teacher allocates time to check through the records/diaries with the children and make a note of the tasks that have been completed. They will then tick or initial to indicate to you at home that their hard efforts have been recognised.

What if I have a question about the homework?

Please feel free to send an email to your child's class teacher, where we will be happy to assist you.

How will I know what my child has been learning at school?

Each week the class teacher will upload pictures with a short blurb to share some of the learning from in school. Please feel free to comment on these and share in the good learning the children have been getting up to.
