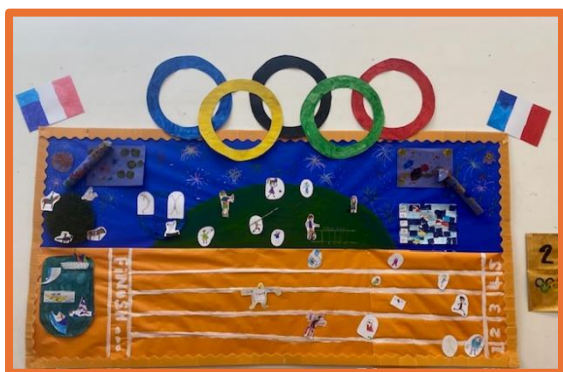
What our staff say...
